


1. Logging into Schoology from a Mobile App (iPhone, iPad, or Android)

The Schoology app, available for phone or tablet, will allow you to view much of your student's homework, classes, and grades in one application. The following directions are to help you log into the Schoology app the first time. Once you have logged in successfully, it will remember your information.

 After downloading the free app (<u>Apple</u> or <u>Android</u>) - On the first screen start to type in Minnetonka and select "Minnetonka Public Schools". Or tap the arrow in the top box.

(Do NOT choose Continue - this brings you to a different login)





4. Tap My Children in the menu.


You will see a listing of courses and grades, groups, recent grades, overdue items, and upcoming assignments and events for one child.

If you have more than one child in the district, tap "More" and then the name of your child. You'll now see a list of all of your children, and can change to the others here.

Please note that parents have view-only access for Schoology. You will not be able to write on the course page, or upload documents to the class page.

5. To see a **Calendar** of assignments and events tap More->Calendar. If you have more than one child, tap More again, tap the name of your child, then tap the name of another of your children from the list.


To see information about an **Assignment**, tap on the name of the assignment.





6. To look at a particular Course or Group, choose the Course or Group from the dropdown menu at the top. You can also tap the course or group title from within your summary feed that you see after you tap My Children from the main menu.

Once inside a course, you can see all materials, assignments, instructions, and updates that your child can see. Use two fingers to zoom in and out within a course.




2. Logging into Schoology from a Laptop or Desktop Computer

 From the Minnetonka homepage, click Single Sign On (SSO) and enter your parent email and password. If you are not sure about how to login to your parent access account, please contact the Family Helpdesk at: family.helpdesk@minnetonkaschools.org


After you are signed into your MyMinnetonka SSO parent access account, you will see your parent applications. One of the available applications is **Schoology**. The screenshot to the left shows your Single Sign-On Application window.





3. Setting Up **Email Notifications** for Updates (like Grades and Missing Assignments)

Your child's teacher may use the Updates, Calendar and Gradebook features on Schoology. Additionally, your child may be enrolled in Groups that may contain timely information about club or sport sign-ups and activities. If so, you can sign up for daily or weekly notifications that will display these items.	
Secondary schools use the Schoology gradebook rather than Skyward for daily grades. Final quarterly grades will be listed Skyward.	
Overdue/missing assignments listed in the email <u>might not have been</u> <u>collected electronically</u> . Ask your student for clarification and contact your child's teacher with questions. You can ignore the attendance column listed in the Schoology email digest since that is found in Skyward.	
Emails you receive from Schoology may contain links that won't open on your phone directly in the app or a mobile browser. Accessing Schoology from a computer when you have already logged in to Schoology is the way to do this.	




4. Viewing Grades in Schoology

Elementary schools (Grades 4-5) may use Schoology for formative/daily classwork, but this is not the official gradebook- Elementary schools use Skyward .

Secondary Schools use the Schoology gradebook rather than Skyward for daily grades. Final semester grades will be listed Skyward.
