Upcoming Scholarships

The dates you see below are the deadlines for each scholarship.

- **September 30** <u>College JumpStart Gratitude Scholarship</u> \$1,000; Current student (high school 10th-12th or college) or planning to enter college within the next 12 months; U.S. citizen or legal resident; answer one of two questions in 250 words or less; financial need is not considered nor are grades or test scores.
- **September 30** <u>Don't Text and Drive Scholarship</u> \$1,000; grades 9-12 or entering college; U.S. citizen or legal resident; submit a 140-character statement about texting and driving.
- **September 30** <u>Going Merry Future Fund Scholarship</u> \$500 no-essay award open to all high school students, no matter your post-graduation plans; money can be used for tuition, books, supplies, or other education-related costs; the application is quick and easy, with no GPA requirement.
