Choose one of the events (up to chapter 20) to cover for the newspaper. Remember that it should be something that would have made waves around the town, not something small or only significant to one person. See below for the expectations and helpful hints for the assignment.

EXPECTATIONS:

- One page, double spaced
- · Headline and byline
- Interesting hook (get the reader interested!)
- 5Ws and 1H
- At least 2 quotes from characters in the book

HELPFUL HINTS:

- Use the columns in Word (under Page Layout) to make the layout more authentic
- Your newspaper is supposed to be from the 1930s, so you may want to use techniques to make it look like it is from that time period (font, colour, etc.)
- Use a picture (or two!) to make the article more realistic
- Choose an event that you have enough information on to write an article about

Be creative and innovative with your story—make sure it's an original

and exciting piece of reporting! Words or jargon from the era should be used to help make your article authentic. You may want to do additional research on your topic to enhance the reader's understanding, as well as your own.
