- Development progress
 - goes well, 15 bug fixes in new release, 4 in QA
- Package structure in Agreements app - real life EBS example (Benjamin)
 - example Springer ebook evidence based selection:
 - Springer English language ebook packages - copyright years, high prices for front list, no pick and choose
 - New: Evidence based selection - license fee = 30% of list price, one year unlimited access, afterwards spend fee to pick titles at list price for perpetual license
 - Bremen: copyright years 2017, 2018, 2019 - License period 15/10/2018 - 14/10/2019 (+4 weeks grace period)
 - Usage is great, so decision to renew: - Select titles for perpetual license only from CY 2017 and 2018, renew for CY 2019 and 2020
 - Union catalogue holdings are automatically updated by VZG service
 - eBook titles are not sufficient for identifying eBooks – adding author and edition – titles are quite similar sometimes
 - Import packages to FOLIO – 2 options – GOKb for standard packages and local KB admin app

- Organizations App - first step adding info here incl. contact people
- User App - adding info for user to then add users
- created 3 Agreements for this example (EBS Engineering (multiyear) - EBS Engineering title picks - EBA Engineering 2017-18 by usage)
- #1 Springer EBS Engineering (multiyear) for original license and renewal - status active and current period and it is not perpetual - AGL periods 2017, 2018, 2019 and renewed after evaluating the high usage and created new AGL for packages 2019, 2020
- 2 AGL for 2019 but with different Active from and Active to dates
- having one Agreement with multiple AGL may make it difficult to understand what happens over the years
- Alternativ you can create new Agreements, but this may clutter your list of Agreements
- #2 second Agreement example: Springer EBS Engineering title picks for collection building selection - status draft (may not be the best wording for this)
- selector documents his decisions of which eBooks to purchase in this Agreement - titles added as Agreement lines
- collecting titles during the EBS period for perpetual access - shadow agreement
- 2 different agreements for collecting the selector's choice and the titles with high usage
- question about "other period" section - automatically done by the system. In this example the Agreement has 2 Agreement periods - #1 is in the past and #2 represents the current renewed ones - #1 is displayed in the "other period" sections
- Question about related agreement - yes in this example they track the related agreement in the dedicated sections
- #3 EBA Engineering 2017-18 by usage: as a note in the example: Books with >70 requests
- those titles as 12 Agreement lines - Is perpetual "yes" status
- Supplementary information: corresponding license with the list of purchased titles
- Excel spreadsheet with usage - titles with high usage will the search in the Agreements / E-resources search & filter - add the title to the basket - add the titles to the existing agreement (procedure to add the individual titles to the agreement)
- URL to local server for files regarding licenses or title lists
- in this example for each EBS period an agreement is created to document 1:1 relationship with title lists
- Question: placeholder location for title to indent to purchase - not about usage
- 2 options 1. add them to the purchased title - but you cannot track why they have been purchased
- 2. to have the titles listed in the "title picks" agreement and then change the status to open/active -
- ideal - to merge 2 Agreement and tag the title with selectors choice or usage - but this is not possible at the moment
- Questions: Can I change the name of the agreement? yes
- Questions: Container type agreement - agreement on top of the agreement?

- start with tagging them to keep them together
- and you can duplicate agreement and you can select the data which should be duplicated - and you can use it for the next here - UUID and name will stay the same
- Questions: Tags - problem keeping track of all the tag you are using -
- Questions: Licenses - in the section "License and business terms" there is no entry right now? → just because the example is prepared only for agreements
- Connection to Order App - more than one PO - multi year agreement
- Can I link order to multiple agreements? It seems to be necessary - multiple to multiple
- need endpoint for calculation of cost per use
- individual title as agreement line, but one PO line to link to
- question: relationship in agreement line - active dates and access dates?
- Active start and end date: AGL as your active package
- Access start and end date: joiners and leavers - title enters or leaves a package
- No prepopulate no connection
- via KB admin tool? --> Active dates would be entered manually when creating the agreement, access dates from GOKb or external source / Active dates in a KB management - dates on the agreement are individual
- their are not coverage ranges
- use case - my agreement has 100 titles, but tomorrow 95 - which 5 titles are missing
