Field Studies in the How People Learn course are multi-media case studies that present authentic challenges that practitioners in various education contexts face. It is crucial to the design of the course that the Field Studies represent accurate and current dilemmas of practice. They are also designed to engage learners, even though the experience is asynchronous. Currently, the Field Studies are presented as pages within Canvas. This project will reimagine the layout and structure of one Field Study to fully embrace the opportunities presented by the asynchronous online medium. Students will explore models of multi-media case studies, develop a set of recommendations or best practices, and create a prototype within the Articulate Rise/Storyline platform.
