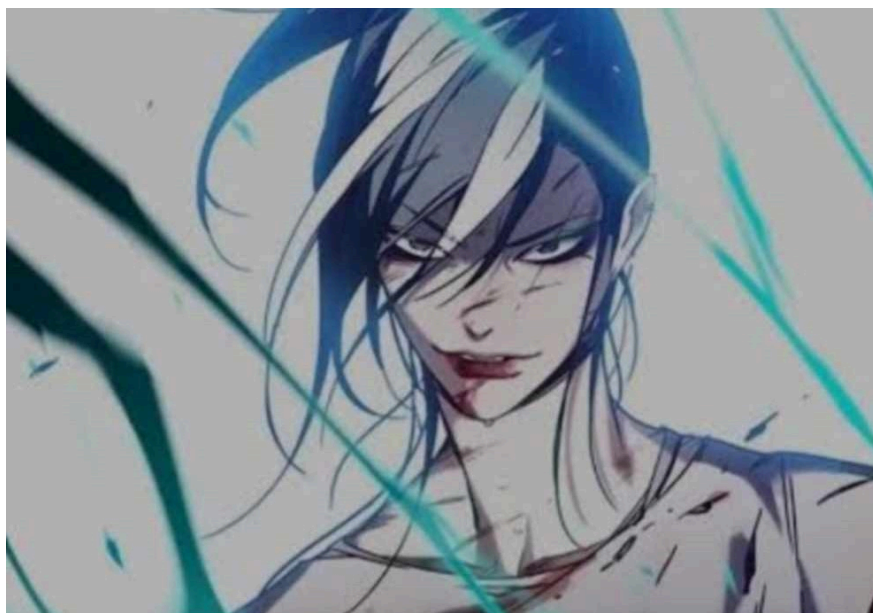

6. **Adjust the volume:**

If you are done choosing the music, you can adjust the volume of your sounds by tapping the “**volume**” on the bottom right side of your screen.

As you can see, there's an "Original Sound" option on the bottom left side. You can use it if you've composed, performed, or recorded your own music or audio. However, you might encounter a copyright claim if the music belongs to someone else.

7. **Adjust the Song Clip:**

When you are done selecting and adjusting the volume of your song, you can also adjust the song's length by tapping the "Scissor" button right side of the song you select.

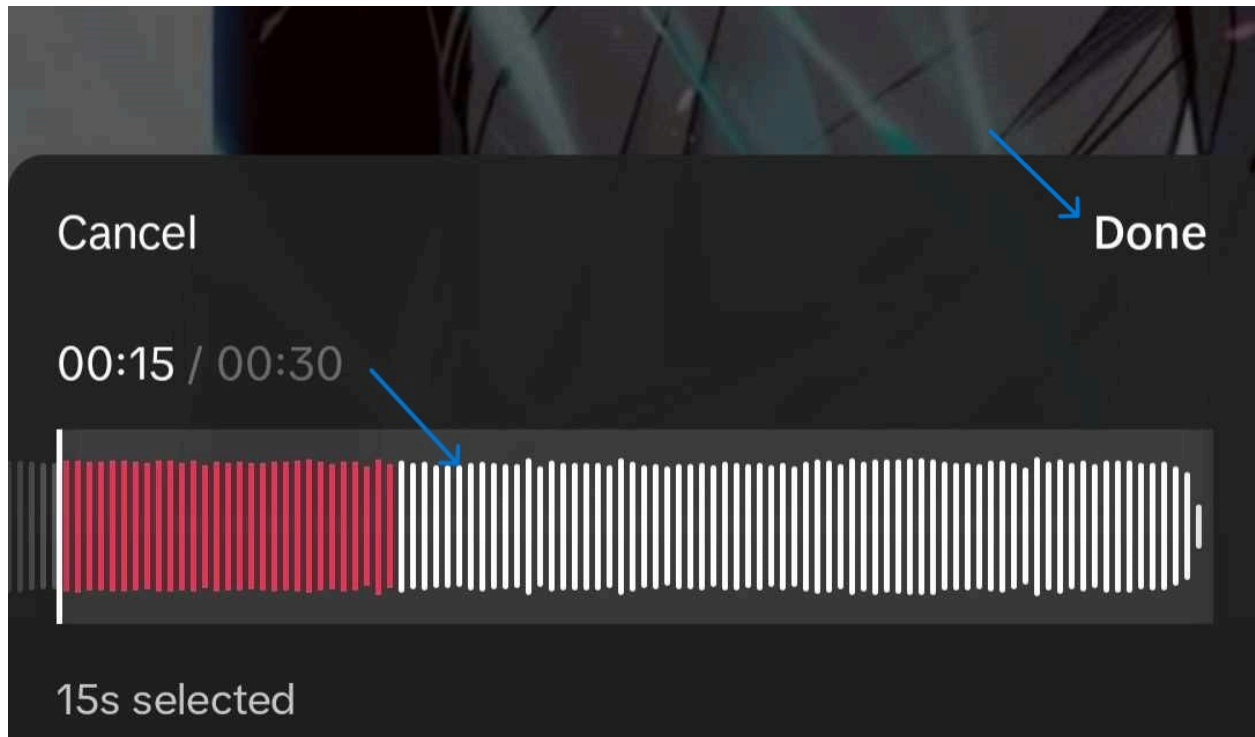

After tapping the “Scissor” button, you will see the adjusting option at the bottom of your screen. After adjusting the song clip, tap “Done.”



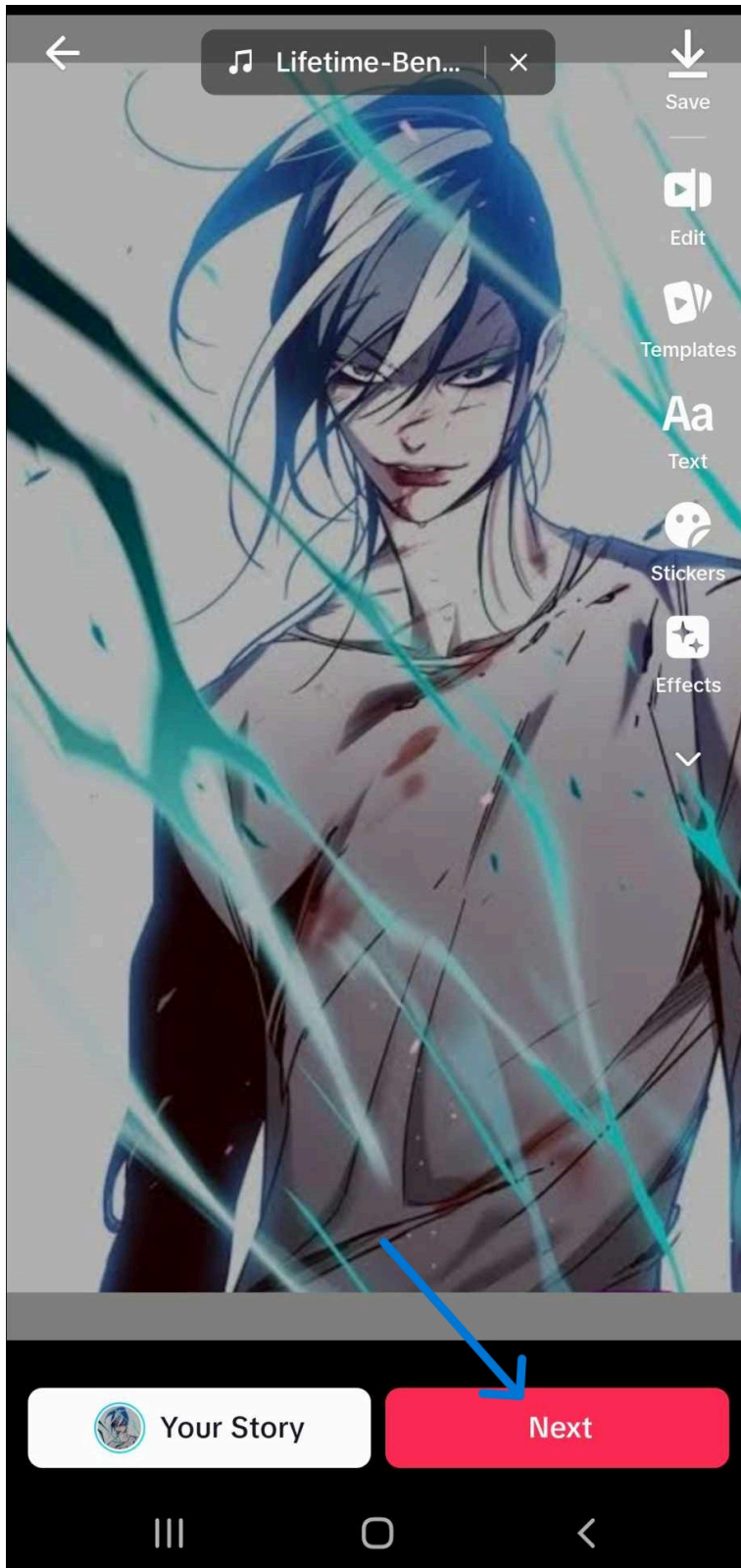
8. **Video Editing:**
