- You can apply for multiple areas, you will just need to fill out each section in the contract below that corresponds with your desired employment.

 - Any work you submit to us is still your own creative property. We will not use anything you submit without your permission.
- From there, you may be asked to interview with one of the Producers from the Network.

Role Description and Individual Application Requirements

Part One: Creators

- 1. As a creator, you will be applying to promote your podcast under the Goose Thunder name.
- 2. Please apply with your first season outlined and ready to be written/recorded/etc., at least one fully written episode script, and a schedule showcasing your plan from outlining to at least the recording of your fifth episode.
 - a. Please know, if you are accepted into the Network, you will be asked for your schedule up to the release of your first episode so the more you can share with us now, the less you will have to show later, should you be accepted into the Network.
 - i. Examples of outline and schedule can be found HERE and HERE.
- 3. If you are accepted into the network we can help find you sound editors, other writers, voice actors, etc., or you can run your own auditions.

Part Two: Writers

- 1. As a writer, you will be under the command of a creator. You will be in charge of helping write episodes for the podcast you are cast for.
- 2. To apply, please provide an example of your scriptwriting. This can either be a past project you did or you can write a short script based on the prompt below:
 - a. "Benny James and Vanya Markov are spies on opposing sides (American and Russian respectively). The two decide to abandon their missions, instead choosing to live together as a married couple in the countryside of Mississippi to try and live out a peaceful life together. Of course, running from your past will eventually catch up with you..."
- 3. Writings must be at least 2 but no more than 15 pages long.

Part Three: Sound Editors

- 1. As a sound editor, you will be under the command of a creator. You will be in charge of editing sound for the episodes of the podcast you are cast for.
- 2. To apply, please follow the link found <u>HERE</u> to find a Google Folder containing the scripts and audio to *Gay Spies Hooray* and *The Ritual*. Your job is to edit the scenes in the script pages as best you can. While editing, keep things like background noise, sound effects, line timing, and volume in mind. **Scripts do not exceed 2 pages.**

Part Four: Composer

- 1. As a composer, you will be under the command of a creator. You will be in charge of composing music for the podcast you are cast in.
- 2. To apply, please submit a recording of an original piece. **Recordings should not exceed 2 minutes total.**

Part Five: Voice Actor

- 3. As a voice actor, you will be under the command of a creator. You will be in charge of voicing the characters of the podcast you are cast in.
- 4. To apply, please submit a recording of this monologue as well as one 90 second monologue of your choice.

Part Six: Graphic Designer

- 1. As a graphic designer, you will be under the command of the creator. You will be in charge of working with the creator to make graphics for the podcast you are cast in.
- 2. To apply, please submit a portfolio of past works and/or a graphic design based on the prompt below:
 - a. "Benny James and Vanya Markov are spies on opposing sides (American and Russian respectively). The two decide to abandon their missions, instead choosing to live together as a married couple in the countryside of Mississippi to try and live out a peaceful life together. Of course, running from your past will eventually catch up with you..."
- 3. Graphic designs do not need to be completed, just let us see your direction. We are not looking for fully realized creations, a rough draft is acceptable in this regard.
