**Assignment** - Students are required to create a book "poster" which encourages other students to read that book for their independent reading at Lee Eaton.

Introduction: Briefly introduce the book WITHOUT giving away too much. Remember you want
other students to read this book. Include:
☐ Title and Author
Describe plot ( setting, main events, conflicts) NO spoilers
Describe the main characters
Discuss the major theme (underlying message or the big idea of the novel)
Review/ Recommendation:
☐ Star rating out of 5 and WHY (5 = best, 1 = worst)
☐ Who would you recommend it to and WHY
Additional information: - choose AT LEAST 3 additional requirements
☐ Tagline or hook that grabs attention

**Format** - Use visuals to aid understanding of your project. You may do the book project however you wish:

☐ A favorite paragraph, line or quote from the book and why you chose that selection
