

Lee Eaton Summer Reading - ONE Free Choice Book!



Overview: Students are encouraged to choose any book of interest that falls in their appropriate reading level range. (Although students are required to read **ONE free-choice book**, it is recommended that students read 3 - 4 books over the summer months to close the gap on summer reading loss.)

Assignment - Students are required to create a book “poster” which encourages other students to read that book for their independent reading at Lee Eaton.

Introduction : Briefly introduce the book WITHOUT giving away too much. Remember you want other students to read this book. Include:

- ☐ **Title and Author**
- ☐ Describe **plot** (setting, main events, conflicts) NO spoilers
- ☐ Describe the **main characters**
- ☐ Discuss the **major theme** (underlying message or the big idea of the novel)

Review/ Recommendation:

- ☐ Star **rating** out of 5 and **WHY** (5 = best, 1 = worst)
- ☐ **Who** would you recommend it to and **WHY**

Additional information: - choose **AT LEAST 3** additional requirements

- ☐ Tagline or hook that grabs attention
- ☐ A link to a quality book trailer from youtube
- ☐ A favorite paragraph, line or quote from the book and why you chose that selection
- ☐ Awards book has won
- ☐ Connections to the book
- ☐ Reflections about the book - no spoilers
