FUNERAL FOR IRVING DAVEY TO BE IN PHILADELPHIA

Burial services will be held Monday in Philadelphia for Irving "Red" Davey, former star athlete at Oshkosh High school and Ripon college, who passed away at 8:10 o'clock Thursday evening at a Philadelphia hospital. He had been ill since last spring.

"Red" Davey, about 56 years old, was graduated from Oshkosh High school in January, 1907, and went to Ripon college where he starred on the football team and on the basketball team.

He had been living in the east for about 30 years, and recently had been working for the government. He served overseas in World war I.

He is survived by his wife, his mother, Mrs. Sarah Davey of Philadelphia; several brothers and sisters, Mrs. Bernice Patterson of St. Petersburg, Fla., Edwin Davey of Folcraft, Pa., Mrs. Gertrude Payer of Philadelphia, and John Davey, graduate of West Point, who is now stationed at the school; three cousins residing in Oshkosh, Mrs. Gladys Farrow, Grace Thomas and LeRoy Thomas; and an aunt, Mrs. Margaret Jones of Oshkosh.
