The Kinze scholarship program has been established to honor Iowa County youth and encourage the development of the next generation of business and technical leaders who will address the great challenges of our time. Kinze is committed to supporting those who have demonstrated a commitment to excellence, a strong work ethic, and community service during their high school years. This is a program that looks beyond academic performance and grades; it rewards the determination to achieve great things through higher education. This investment in those selected for the scholarship award shows Kinze's pride and continued endorsement of our future leaders.

CRITERIA:

1. Graduating senior from Williamsburg High School
2. Have demonstrated good attendance throughout high school
3. Have earned a minimum 2.5 grade point average
4. Have recognized leadership abilities through participation in community service, extracurricular or other youth activities.
5. Indicate evidence of a strong work ethic and determination to succeed.
6. Be planning to attend a 2 or 4 year college/university or vocational/technical school.
7. Need a written recommendation from a teacher or school official
8. Need a written recommendation from someone outside the school that is not a relative.

PAYMENT:

The money may be awarded once during their first four semesters of college. It is the student's responsibility to send a copy of the tuition bill to Mr. Dave Volkens. You will receive instructions once awarded. Farmers Trust and Savings Bank will then send a check to the college/university or vocational/technical school to have the scholarship money applied directly to the student's tuition bill.

WALTER & GRACE TALBOT MEMORIAL LONGVIEW FARM

CRITERIA:

1. Graduate of Williamsburg High School
2. May be given to either a boy or girl with a financial need in the pursuance of a higher education
3. Major area of study must be home economics or agriculture
4. The same sex cannot be given the scholarship more than two years in a row. A graduate may receive this scholarship only once. (FEMALE 2022)

WILLIAMSBURG MANUFACTURING SCHOLARSHIPS

CRITERIA:

Williamsburg Manufacturing donates two \$500.00 scholarships annually to the R.O.T.E. foundation. The recipients of this award must have demonstrated community and school service, a high grade point average, good school attendance, and will be attending a post secondary institution after graduation.

JOHN WARD STEVENSON SCHOLARSHIP

CRITERIA:

This scholarship is possible and funded by a gift from Lucy Stevenson. Her husband, John, was an Iowa County grain and livestock producer from Sumner Township. This award originated in 1989 as the original ROTE endowment. Funds from this endowment are disbursed annually.

- Must be a Williamsburg High School graduate with a "C" average or better

- Must be a graduate in need of financial assistance
- Will not be the recipient of another scholarship. If another ROTE scholarship is received, this scholarship will be rescinded and passed to another candidate.
- Is renewable for ensuing years if the student is maintaining at least a "C" average or continuing to show improvement in grades
- Scholarship may be used at a technical school, community college, 2 year college or 4 year college

No criteria. Two \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded. Funds will be disbursed however the R.O.T.E. Committee desires.

GARY & JUDY STEVENS SCHOLARSHIP

Two \$1000.00 scholarships will be awarded

ROTE SCHOLARSHIP

\$500.00 scholarship

A selection committee appointed by the membership of the corporation will make the final determination. Applicants will be considered regardless of sex, race, national origin, disability, or creed.

CTC Technology Scholarship

CTC Technology Scholarship in the amount of \$500 is available to graduates of the Williamsburg Community High School. Any graduate who plans to enter into an IT, Networking, Computer or Telecommunications field is eligible to apply. Funds should be used for tools, books, or tuition. The R.O.T.E. Committee will select the winner, and a CTC representative will present the award.
