SOC205 Week 5 Reflection Assignment

Purpose

For your weekly reflection, you will have an opportunity to review the course material and consider how it relates to you and your experiences. This week, you'll explore stratification, colonization, globalization, and other economic reasons for inequality and social change.

Tasks

- 1. All students respond to one of the Reflection prompt options.
 - a. Worth 15 points, due 11:59 pm February 10
 - b. Take some time to reflect on what you have learned from working on your Padlet so far in class and the comments you received from your instructor and classmates.
 - c. Identify 3 economic influences on social change that impact your community. These can be historical causes of social change, current issues, or future changes that might impact the economic outcomes in your community.
 - d. Update your padlet to include at least three additional posts that focus on the historical and current or future economic forces that drive social change in your community. Use the tools on the Padlet to provide links to outside sources in any form: articles, web pages, images, audio, and video are all fine. Be sure to include enough text for your reader to understand the context of what you link.
 - e. Write a short reflection on what you learned, what questions you still have related to your community and social change, or the communities of the other students.
 - f. Your post should be 150-200 words and should define and cite at least one sociological concept or key word in your initial post.
 - g. Interact on Padlet by adding 3 to 5 comments or likes to other students' entries.
 - h. Submit your response to the prompt to the Week 5 Reflection Assignment discussion board via Canvas.

Criteria for Success

Grading Notes: I will grade based on your initial post (150-200 words), including a definition/application of at least one sociological term or concept, and your response to 3-5 other students. Your response to other posts should be 100-150 words and could answer what made you think, what made you curious to know more, or what you resonated with, you should go beyond "Great answer" or "Good Job." Also, as good scientists, we cite our sources. Please remember to use parentheses in your text, like (Krouskop 2022:3), AND add the complete citation at the end of your post.
