Abstract should be clear and informative, providing a statement for the problem under study and its solution. Abstract length between 150 to 250 words. Avoid unusual abbreviations and define all symbols used in the abstract. Using keywords related to the research topic is recommended.

INTRODUCTION (Font Size 11pt)

The article is made into a 1-column page with A4 paper size. For Top Margin 2 cm, Left Margin 2 cm, Bottom Margin 2 cm, and Right Margin 2 cm. The manuscript is created using Microsoft Word, single space, 11 pt Times New Roman, and no more than 8-10 pages.

Please select the title of the article (maximum 20 words) with the least words that may be necessary to adequately describe the content. The introduction should describe the background of the research, the solutions offered and comparable related work. If there is a quote in the article, it is MANDATORY to use APA STYLE and so on by using the MENDELEY citation tool in APA format. Terms in foreign languages are written in italics. In the first paragraph, describe what is the problem in the research (in the form of a paragraph description), also describe what is expected to be the solution to the problem in your research. Next, describe related research that is similar to your research (at least 5) with an update of 5 years before, so that with this related research can emerge a GAP Analysis of the research you conducted.

At the end of the introduction, describe the goals of your research and the expectations you want to achieve from your research. It is recommended for the Author to use the following article structure: INTRODUCTION (min 700 words) – METHOD (min 500 words) – RESULT (min 1800 words) DISCUSSION (min 800 words) – CONCLUSION (min 200 words). A maximum of 8-10 pages of articles.

METHOD

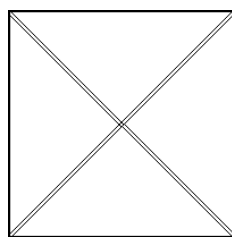

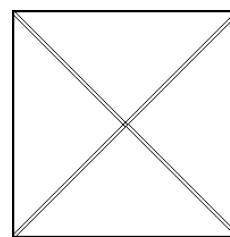

References must be in the **American Psychological Association (APA) 7th Edition** and arranged in alphabetical order. Please do not include any abbreviations. Any additional references must be included in the Supplementary Reading section, with a total of **at least 15 references**. MUST use **MENDELEY**. And there must be a **DOI** for each cited article.
