Homework Expectations

Third graders are expected to read 20 minutes every night. Research has shown that reading with your child daily is one of the most important factors predicting student success in school. Then, ask questions about what they are reading. For example;

1. Who are the characters in the story?
2. What is the story mostly about?
3. What is the problem in the story?
4. Is there a solution to the problem?

Students are also expected to practice math concepts. Each night your child will complete a lesson in their Simple Solutions workbook. Throughout the year, your child will be expected to complete other assignments.
