Qualifications

- Must be a QMA on the Registry and have completed the Insulin Administration module.
- Pass the QMA-Insulin written competency exam. QMA Insulin exams are administered at Ivy Tech Testing Centers statewide.

Required Documentation

- **Application:** Original IDOH Test application for QMA Insulin completed online at https://apps.ivytech.edu/apps/ext/cnaqma/
 - Must have QMA number on the Registry before applying for the Insulin exam
- Payment: Credit/debit card payment is made online in the application process

Scheduling the exam: Ivy Tech Community College will contact the candidate by email with instructions to schedule their exam at any Ivy Tech Campus Testing Center through an online scheduling system. Candidates will be able to select the Ivy Tech Campus Testing Center that works best for their location and date/time available.
