Kids at Grace

By the entrance into the sanctuary, busy bags are available for children to use. During the 10:15 service, before the sermon, Ms. Coli will take children (3 and older) to the other building for an engaging lesson about our hope in Jesus. Children are returned to their families right after the prayers. There is also a quiet room outside the sanctuary with toys and the live stream, if families need a place for younger children throughout the service.

Holy Communion

This meal is weird and wonderful: weird because we actually believe that the bread and wine are the Body and Blood of Jesus the Christ; wonderful because Jesus is with us. We take this meal very seriously here at Grace. If you have any questions or concerns, please reach out and allow us to answer your questions. **Children** who have not been instructed in the meaning of the Sacrament may come to the Lord's Table with their parents for a blessing but are asked to fold their arms across their chests to indicate they are to receive a blessing.

THE DISTRIBUTION OF THE COMMUNION: After the closing hymn, Pastor will pronounce the sending and then for those who wish to share in the celebration of communion shall remain. ***For those who have an intolerance to wine, grape juice is lighter colored on the tray, center.*** Those who find it difficult to walk to the altar can be communed at your seat. Please inform the usher of your need. After the Pastor has given your group the blessing at the altar, you may place your cup in the basket and depart from the Sanctuary down the center aisle, and enjoy fellowship in the hall.

Up-Root and Plant

New growth requires broken ground. In Jeremiah, we experience the heavy work of God's Law uprooting our self-reliance, making way for the Gospel to plant us securely in His grace.

Den of Robbers

It's incredibly easy to look at the world, point fingers, and feel secure just because we are the righteous. Jeremiah 7 shows us how God wants to uproot our pride and plant His grace.

THE FIRST LESSON Jeremiah 7:1-15

God warns the people through Jeremiah at the temple gate: trusting in the temple alone will not save them; they must reform their ways.

This is the word that came to Jeremiah from the Lord: "Stand at the gate of the Lord's house and there proclaim this

message:

"Hear the word of the Lord, all you people of Judah who come through these gates to worship the Lord. This is what the Lord Almighty, the God of Israel, says: Reform your ways and your actions, and I will let you live in this place. Do not trust in deceptive words and say, "This is the temple of the Lord, the temple of the Lord, the temple of the Lord!" If you really change your ways and your actions and

deal with each other justly, if you do not oppress the foreigner, the fatherless or the widow and do not shed innocent blood in this place, and if you do not follow other gods to your own harm, then I will let you live in this place, in the land I gave your ancestors for ever and ever. But look, you are trusting in deceptive words that are worthless.

“Will you steal and murder, commit adultery and perjury, burn incense to Baal and follow other gods you have not known, and then come and stand before me in this house, which bears my Name, and say, “We are safe”—safe to do all these detestable things? Has this house, which bears my Name, become a den of robbers to you? But I have been watching!

declares the Lord.

“Go now to the place in Shiloh where I first made a dwelling for my Name, and see what I did to it because of the wickedness of my people Israel. While you were doing all these things, declares the Lord, I spoke to you again and again, but you did not listen; I called you, but you did not answer. Therefore, what I did to Shiloh I will now do to the house that bears my Name, the temple you trust in, the place I gave to you and your ancestors. I will thrust you from my presence, just as I did all your fellow Israelites, the people of Ephraim.’

THE SECOND LESSON

1 Corinthians 3:10-17

Building carefully upon the only true foundation of Jesus Christ, we recognize that together we are God's sacred temple where His Spirit dwells.

By the grace God has given me, I laid a foundation as a wise builder, and someone else is building on it. But each one should build with care. For no one can lay any foundation other than the one already laid, which is Jesus Christ. If anyone builds on this foundation using gold, silver, costly stones, wood, hay or straw, their work will be shown for what it is, because the Day will bring it to light.

It will be revealed with fire, and the fire will test the quality of each person's work. If what has been built survives, the builder will receive a reward. If it is burned up, the builder will suffer loss but yet will be saved—even though only as one escaping through the flames.

Don't you know that you yourselves are God's temple and that God's Spirit dwells in your midst? If anyone destroys God's temple, God will destroy that person; for God's temple is sacred, and you together are that temple.

Reader: This is the Word of the Lord.

Matthew 21:12-17

Jesus clears the temple courts, returns it to a place of prayer, and heals the sick and blind.

Jesus entered the temple courts and drove out all who were buying and selling there. He overturned the tables of the money changers and the benches of those selling doves. "It is written," he said to them, "'My house will be called a house of prayer,' but you are making it 'a den of robbers.'"

The blind and the lame came to him at the temple, and he healed them. But when the

chief priests and the teachers of the law saw the wonderful things he did and the children shouting in the temple courts, "Hosanna to the Son of David," they were indignant.

"Do you hear what these children are saying?" they asked him.

"Yes," replied Jesus, "have you never read,

"From the lips of children and infants you, Lord, have called forth your praise'?"

And he left them and went out of the city to Bethany, where he spent the night.

Questions for the Week: Up-Root and Plant

1. Read Jeremiah 7:1-15. In Jeremiah's day, the people thought chanting "The temple of the Lord!" would keep them safe, regardless of how they lived. What are the modern "safety blankets" (routines, traditions, or labels) we use to convince ourselves we are better than others?
2. Read Matthew 21:12-15. How does seeing a "den of robbers" as a safe hideout where robbers retreat to feel secure and boast, rather than a crime scene, change your view of Jesus overturning the tables?
3. It is easy to look at our culture and feel a sense of superiority because we are sitting in church. Why is this kind of religious pride so dangerous to our faith?
4. When Jesus cleared the temple, He immediately welcomed the blind and the lame (the outcasts). How does knowing that Jesus died for the "uprooted" give you true security and hope?

Cris's weekly input: Sermon Summary: Main Idea, Key Points, and Questions:

Jeremiah 7:1-15 1 Corinthians 3:10-17 Matthew 21:12-17

Pastor Cris's Summary:

This sermon continues the "Uproot and Plant" series by looking at Jeremiah's famous Temple Sermon. The people of Judah were living in blatant, unrepentant sin—oppressing the poor, neglecting the widow, and worshiping Baal—yet they felt completely safe because they had the physical Temple. They chanted, "The temple of the Lord!" like a magic spell. God reminds them of Shiloh, where their ancestors tried to use the Ark of the Covenant as a lucky charm and were destroyed. Jeremiah accuses them of turning God's house into a "den of robbers"—a hideout where criminals go to feel safe and brag after doing evil.

The sermon directly applies this to modern confessional pride, warning against the temptation to look down on neighbors or other Christians while using our "correct" doctrine or church attendance as a false hideout. The Gospel arrives when Jesus walks into the Temple in Matthew 21, quotes Jeremiah, kicks out the proud money-changers, and then quotes Isaiah 56—declaring the Temple a house of prayer for all nations, including the outcast. Jesus immediately heals the blind and lame right there in the Temple, proving that true security isn't found in our religious pride, but in the God who gives up everything on the cross to bring the uprooted and broken inside.
