- 2. Select **Apply to Teach.**
- 3. Please enter your name, title/position, and address, and select which AEA(s) you will teach for.
- 4. Enter your work address and contact information.
- 5. Enter your educational background. **Include the Iowa Board of Educational Examiners (BoEE) folder number if applicable.** All professional development instructors will have
  earned a master's degree or have expertise or training in their
  field, which qualifies them to lead professional development. A
  valid lowa license, such as a BoEE license, is preferred for
  instructors of license renewal and graduate credit courses.
- 6. Transcript
  - a. If BoEE is evident (Master Educator License), then no transcript is needed.
  - b. If you do not have an IA Master Educator license, submit your transcripts.
  - c. If you are an "expert in your field," submit your transcripts.
- 7. Professional Work Experience

- a. Type **specific details** in the open field **or attach a CV or resume.**
- 8. Additional options for Vita submission
  - a. Leadership activities
  - b. Additional certifications & teacher licensure
  - c. Publications/Books
  - d. Professional memberships
- 9. Don't forget to **Save** Vita and then **Submit.**
- 10. You will receive an email once your Vita has been approved. Please allow 24–48 hours for the approval process.
- 11. Once approved, you will gain access to the <u>course proposal</u> and an <u>instructor tab</u> located on the left-hand side menu of the screen.
