Introduction

Windsor Charter Academy's administration and student athletes are looking forward to hosting home athletic events this season (810 Automation Dr., Windsor, CO 80550). With our current state and county COVID-19 restrictions in place, we have built in additional guidelines and procedures to make our events as safe as possible. Below you will find detailed information on how we are opting to run our home athletic events.

At Windsor Charter Academy, we are committed to keeping our athletes, families, and visiting teams safe. COVID-19 safeguards are in place to make every effort to maintain the health and safety of all participants. Attention to and support of these protocols is important to minimize the risk of disrupting the season for some or all participants. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation. Indoor Event Guidelines & Procedures (HS Volleyball/MS Basketball)

- ❑ The Girls' [Volleyball Bulletin](#) is published yearly to offer information on the regular season and postseason, important dates, along with CHSAA and NFHS rules and procedures.
- ❑ All players and coaches must wear a mask at all times, NO EXCEPTIONS. Masks must be worn over the nose and mouth. Participation is a privilege, not a right. Players and coaches must also practice social distancing whenever possible.
- ❑ All student athletes, whether they are entering WCA's facilities to play a game, or if they are traveling to a game, must have a temperature and symptom check. If any athlete has COVID-19 symptoms and/or a temperature of 100.3 or higher, they will not be permitted to enter the building or to travel to away games.
- ❑ Visiting teams should arrive together and enter the middle school entrance on the east side of the school. Players should arrive dressed for the game. Limited locker room use will be available. Visiting teams can utilize the commons area while waiting for their next game to begin.
- ❑ Each team is allowed 18 total individuals to include 12 players, 3 coaches, 1 videographer/photographer, 1 bookkeeper, and 1 manager.
- ❑ No band or cheer/spirit team will be allowed from the home or visiting school. Each team may have a team videographer on the top row of the bleachers.
- ❑ Bleachers will be sectioned off for spectators with home team, visiting team, and a student section.

- ❑ All game-day personnel must wear a mask and must practice social distancing at all times with anyone who is not a member of their family. (Please see spectator guidelines below).
- ❑ Concessions will not be available.
- ❑ Visiting teams are to remain in MS Commons while they are waiting for the next game if they are not utilizing the allotted visiting spectator tickets.
- ❑ Players, coaches, and all participants on the sideline must use their own water bottle. Student athletes are strongly encouraged to have a spill-proof water bottle with a collapsible straw to allow for drinking with the mask on.
- ❑ As soon as the game ends, an announcement will be made instructing teams and spectators to leave.

Indoor Athletic Event Spectator Guidelines

- ❑ Spectator limitations will follow the [Capacity Restrictions](#) for Weld County.
- ❑ Admissions fees will **not** be charged at Windsor Charter Academy events. Online tickets will be available through [Hometown Ticketing](#).
- ❑ All spectators are required to wear a protective face covering for admission and throughout the duration of any event. Failure to comply will result in removal.
- ❑ Bleacher seating will be clearly marked with "section banners" for **Home Team, Visiting Team, and Student Section**. It is the responsibility of spectators to social distance in the bleachers.
- ❑ Chairs and ADA accommodations can be made upon request.
- ❑ All participants must be seated in a seat and not congregating in the MS Commons during the game.
- ❑ Spectators should remain in their vehicles until doors open.
- ❑ No tail-gating or group gatherings in the parking lots or outside the school entrance/exit doors.
- ❑ Event entry will occur through the east middle school doors.
- ❑ No unauthorized person can come to the entry doors and be admitted.
- ❑ No concessions will be available.
- ❑ If a child is using a spectator ticket, the child must remain seated in the gym at all times with a guardian.
- ❑ Event exit will occur through the north gym doors.
- ❑ Sanitizing wipes will be available to all teams, spectators, and guests.
- ❑ WCA will attempt to stream a live broadcast to all games this season. This live broadcast will be provided as a courtesy to our families and visiting teams. Please note that connectivity and availability issues may prevent live-streaming and therefore live streaming will not always be guaranteed. Outdoor Event Guidelines & Procedures (HS Boys' Soccer / MS Boys' Soccer)

- ❑ The CHSAA Boys' Soccer [Bulletin](#) is published yearly to offer information on the regular season and postseason, important dates, along with CHSAA and NFHS rules and procedures.
- ❑ All players and coaches **must** wear a mask at all times except during play in accordance with state/county/local health guidelines. NO EXCEPTIONS. Masks must be worn over the nose and mouth. Participation is a privilege, not a right. Players and coaches must also practice social distancing whenever possible.
- ❑ All game-day personnel must wear a mask and must practice social distancing at all times with anyone who is not a member of their family. (Please see spectator guidelines below).
- ❑ Coaches must remain in the regular team box, but box width for student athletes and other bench personnel should be flexible to allow social distancing.
- ❑ Benches should not be used during games. WCA will utilize stadium seating for team benches to promote greater social distancing when available.
- ❑ If social distancing can't be achieved with both team benches on the same side, team benches may be set up on opposite sides of the field.
- ❑ There must be a minimum 10 feet distance between spectators and team benches.
- ❑ All student athletes, whether they are entering WCA's facilities to play a game, or if they are traveling to a game, must have a temperature and symptom check. If any athlete has COVID-19 symptoms and/or a temperature of 100.3 or higher, they will not be permitted to enter the building or to travel to away games.
- ❑ Visiting teams should arrive together and enter the middle school entrance on the east side of the school. Players should arrive dressed for the game. Locker room use will be available.
- ❑ Live stream video of the outdoor games will not be offered.
- ❑ Visiting teams are to remain in the MS Commons while they are waiting for the next game if they are not utilizing the allotted visiting spectator tickets.
- ❑ Players, coaches, and all participants on the sideline must use their own water bottle. Student athletes are strongly encouraged to have a spill-proof water bottle with a collapsible straw to allow for drinking with the mask on.
- ❑ As soon as the game ends, an announcement will be made instructing teams and spectators to leave.

- ❑ Bleacher seating will be available with limited capacity. It is the responsibility of spectators to social distance in the bleachers. It is recommended that spectators bring lawn chairs and spread out around the perimeter of the field.
- ❑ Chairs and ADA accommodations can be made upon request.
- ❑ No tail-gating or group gatherings in the parking lots or outside the soccer field entrance.
- ❑ No unauthorized person can come to the entry doors and be admitted.
- ❑ No concessions will be available.
- ❑ Sanitizing wipes will be available to all teams, spectators, and guests.
