

# The City of Ember Week Two Vocabulary

**Instructions:** Use each of the eight required words in a piece of writing. Your writing can be a narrative short story, script, informational, argumentative, or...? However, you must use the words in a way that demonstrates your understanding of the meaning of use of each word. In addition, please be sure to **highlight each word** in your writing for full credit. Your paper should be a full page in length. Finally, you will have a spelling and definition quiz over the eight required words on **Friday**.

Equipp(ed) (v) - supply with the necessary items for a particular purpose. EX. All classrooms were equipped with twenty desks and chairs.

Muffled (adj) - not loud because of being obstructed in some way; muted. EX. In the next room, you could hear the sound of muffled conversation.

Immensely (adv) - to a great extent; extremely. EX. The dog is immensely in love with the ball.

Outburst (v) - a sudden outbreak of a particular activity. EX. After the performance, there was an outburst of applause.

Fluster(ed) (v) - make (someone) agitated or confused. EX. Being late to school made her flustered.

Examined (v) - inspect (someone or something) in detail to determine their nature or condition; investigate thoroughly. EX. After getting into a car accident, the driver was examined at the hospital.

Threadbare- (of cloth, clothing, or soft furnishings) becoming thin and tattered with age EX. The room was shabby with threadbare curtains hung across each window.

Scolding (n) - an angry rebuke or reprimand. EX. The puppy had an accident on the carpet and received a stern scolding.
