# A BUDGET BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO AMEND THE FISCAL YEAR 2022 - 2023 STUDENT GOVERNMENT BUDGET FOR THE PURPOSES OF ADDING A NEW LINE ITEM FOR THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT CAMPOUT INITIATIVE

WHEREAS, Campout was a tradition at NC State from the 1980s through 2018; and,

**WHEREAS**, one of the initiatives on the Heavlin-Reid Platform was to re-establish Campout in the 102nd Session of Student Government; and,

WHEREAS, the Student Government Athletics Department has been tasked by the Heavlin-Reid Administration to coordinate, plan, and execute the revived Campout in the 102nd Session of Student Government; and,

- **WHEREAS**, the Student Government Athletics Department is actively planning Campout and it is scheduled to take place in December 2022; and,
- **WHEREAS**, since this initiative involves multiple expenditures, an internal budget is created; and,
- WHEREAS, due to the number of expenses required, more recordkeeping and accounting work is required on behalf of the Treasury Branch compared to normal departmental budgets that go through the Internal Funding Process; and,
- **WHEREAS**, for the ease of recordkeeping and accounting, it is recommended a new Line Item be established in the Fiscal Year 2022 2023 Student Government Budget to capture and record the expenses related to the SG Campout initiative; and,
- **WHEREAS**, this Budget Bill does not budget unbudgeted funds, but only create a new line item in the Fiscal Year 2022 2023 Student Government Budget for the SG Campout initiative;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED**, that the North Carolina State University Student Senate amend the Fiscal Year 2022 - 2023 Student Government Budget to establish a new line item as shown below:

200 - Initiatives and Campus Support			
			This line shall be disbursed to pay for expenditures related to the Student Government Campout initiative organized by the Student Government Athletics Department. This line shall be expended by majority consent of the Student Body President, Student Body
	203 - SG Campout	\$0.00	Vice President, and Student Government Director of Athletics with the advisement of the Student Government Advisor.

; and be it further

- **ENACTED**, that the North Carolina State University Student Senate recommend to the Student Body Treasurer to transfer funds from Line Item 201 Student Government Initiatives to fund this new line item; and be it further
- **ENACTED**, in compliance with the Student Body Statutes, the Student Government Athletics

  Department shall be required to submit a budget for approval through the Internal

  Funding Process before expending funds from this line item; and be it further
- **ENACTED**, in compliance with the Student Body Constitution, all expenditures of funds from this line item is subject to the approval of the Student Body Treasurer; and be it further
- **ENACTED**, that the Student Body Treasurer shall have the discretion to transfer funds between this line item and other line items within the budget as allowed by the Student Body Constitution, Student Body Statutes, and the FY 2022 2023 Budget Act; and be it further,

**ENACTED**, this bill shall become effective upon its enrollment.
