 - d) Orchestra will go, still deciding on other bands
- 3) Jazz Festival Saturday December 10th:
 - a) No funding so far from Ed-Fund
 - b) \$450 x 3 to 4 adjudicators plus their lunch. Total of approx \$1600
 - c) Will be schools from SRVUSD and outside the district
 - d) Maybe setup snack bar this year
 - e) Will be in the PAC

 - b) No jazz or marching band
