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Abstract

The abstract is written in one paragraph with a maximum of 200 words, using 11-point Cambria font and 1.0 spacing. The abstract is written in **English** and **Indonesian**.

Keywords: 3-4 words that indicate the focus of the research

INTRODUCTION (Cambria, 12, Capital, Bold)

The introduction consists of several paragraphs (7-8 paragraphs) explaining the academic concerns that prompted the author to conduct research on the specified focus, including an introduction to the practical/theoretical problems closely related to the research focus, the uniqueness of the research object, confirmation of the research focus, discourse on relevant previous studies, confirmation of the novelty or distinction of the research focus, confirmation of theoretical urgency, and research practice. The description in the introduction chapter is written using Cambria font, size 12, 1.15 spacing.

RESEARCH METHODS (Cambria, 12, Capital, Bold)

The research methods chapter is written in a descriptive and clear style. The author provides explanations regarding the research methods instruments used, such as the type of research, research approach, data sources, data collection techniques, and analysis methods, among other things. The description in this introductory chapter is written using Cambria font, size 12, with 1.15 spacing.

RESULTS AND DISCUSSION (Cambria, 12, Capital, Bold)

This chapter on results and discussion includes at least three subchapters: theoretical framework, conceptual framework, and findings. The findings chapter can be classified into several subchapters according to the number of findings. The classification of findings subchapters can be written using numbering (1.2.3, and so on). The description in the results and discussion chapter uses Cambria font, size 12, 1.0 spacing, and 1.15 spacing.

CONCLUSION (Cambria, 12, Capital, Bold)

This conclusion chapter can be broken down into two paragraphs. The first paragraph outlines the major findings and detailed findings, explanations or reinforcements. The second paragraph outlines the theoretical contributions of the research, the limitations of the research, practical recommendations, and further research. The writing in this results and discussion chapter uses Cambria font, size 12, 1.15 spacing.

REFERENCES (Cambria, 12, Capital, Bold)

Minimum of 25 references, with 70% of references from scientific journals published within the last five years. It is recommended to include more references from reputable international indexed journals. References should be listed alphabetically and arranged according to the American Psychological Association (APA) reference style (7th edition). All references must be cited in the text, and all citations in the text must be listed in the reference list. The DOI for each reference must be included if available. Authors are advised to use reference management applications such as Mendeley or Zotero. The text in

the results and discussion chapters should be written in Cambria font, size 12, with 1.15 line spacing.
