Who is the job for?

- Emma Frankland, Marlborough Productions, Wildworks and Andy Kesson are looking for Lighting, Video and Sound Technicians and Operators
- The positions will last from 17th April - 22nd May
- We would particularly like to receive applications from people within LGBTQIA+, Global Majority, Deaf, Disabled, Neurodivergent and Lower Socio-Economic communities

What is Galatea?

- Galatea was written by John Lyly and inspired Shakespeare 400 years ago
- Galatea is about love, joy and welcoming outsiders
- Galatea will be a large-scale, outdoor production
- Galatea will take place on Adur Recreation Ground in Shoreham-by-Sea
- Galatea will be a bilingual production in both British Sign Language and English
- Galatea will be performed by an intersectional Deaf and hearing cast with a chorus of community performers

What are the roles?

- **Lighting & Video Technician- Lighting Bias Role** - to lead the installation and running of the lighting system and oversee the video system.
- **Lighting & Video Technician- Video Bias** - to be part of the installation and overseeing of the lighting system and running of the video system
- **Sound Engineer & Operator** - to lead the sound team - leading system planning, running the installation of the sound system and live engineering/operating
- **Sound Technician** - to support the Sound Engineer & Operator in installing the sound system, rigging and system maintenance and work with the cast to fit and problem solve radio mic headsets and packs

- **Tech week:** w/c 24th April (days TBC)
- **Production week:** w/c 1st May (days TBC)
- **Preview:** Friday 5th May, 8pm
- **Performances:** Saturday 6th - Sunday 21st May (Wednesday - Sunday), 8pm and Sunday 14th & Saturday 21st May, 2pm

What is the offer?

- There is a £800 a week fee for each position based on a 5 day working week (48 hours max)

- Any additional time required during installation and tech will be paid on top of the weekly fee
- Working days will be agreed with the successful candidates
