Tips for Writing a Good Conclusion

1. **Restate your main idea or thesis** in different words.
2. **Summarize the main arguments** or points you discussed.
3. **Show the importance** of your topic - why it matters locally or globally.
4. **End with a strong final thought** - a prediction, recommendation, or reflection.
5. **Avoid** introducing new information or examples in the conclusion.
6. **Think of your conclusion as the "final word"** - the part that connects everything together and leaves your reader with something to think about.
