

**January 1947: *Kane County Standard*, “Utah is Hollywood’s Back Door”**

*Kane County Standard was a local newspaper based in Kanab, UT. This source has an interesting typo: it talks about movies made since “196.” While the writers could have meant 1946, it is difficult to be sure. As you read, think about whether that typo should affect how you interpret the source.*

“A survey of motion picture activity in Utah since 196 reveals that more than thirty pictures (or important parts of pictures) have been made in the state. Approximately \$9,000,000 has been spent by Hollywood producers in Utah for the use of extras, horses, cattle, locations, housing, feeding, and transportation.”
