Being a senior club, we should also recognize Ted as our longest continuous club member, belonging since 1984 and serving as past president. We also have two members who reached 90 within the past year. Don Miyada, who played yesterday, and our treasurer, Skee Gutmacher, who intended to play, but missed, due to a hopefully minor setback.. We wish him well.

For the tournament of the September 17 day only, we had an unusual five way tie for first. Ron Plummer, Wayne Rowell, John Muesse, Mike Wolter and Chuck Friedersdorf all posted net 64's.
