FAKE THEFT (Alfonso, Blanca, Crisina, Rafa)

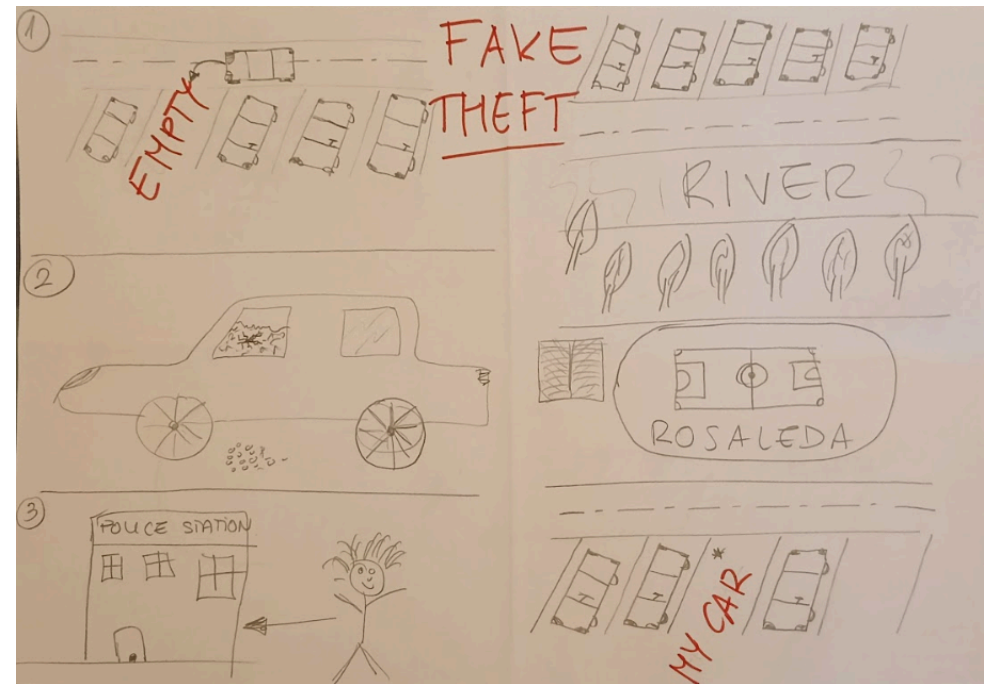
This story was something that happened to my friend Alfonso 7 or 8 years ago. It was about his car.

Police investigated the incident, in the end, it turned out that my car hadn't been stolen. I forgot where I parked my car.

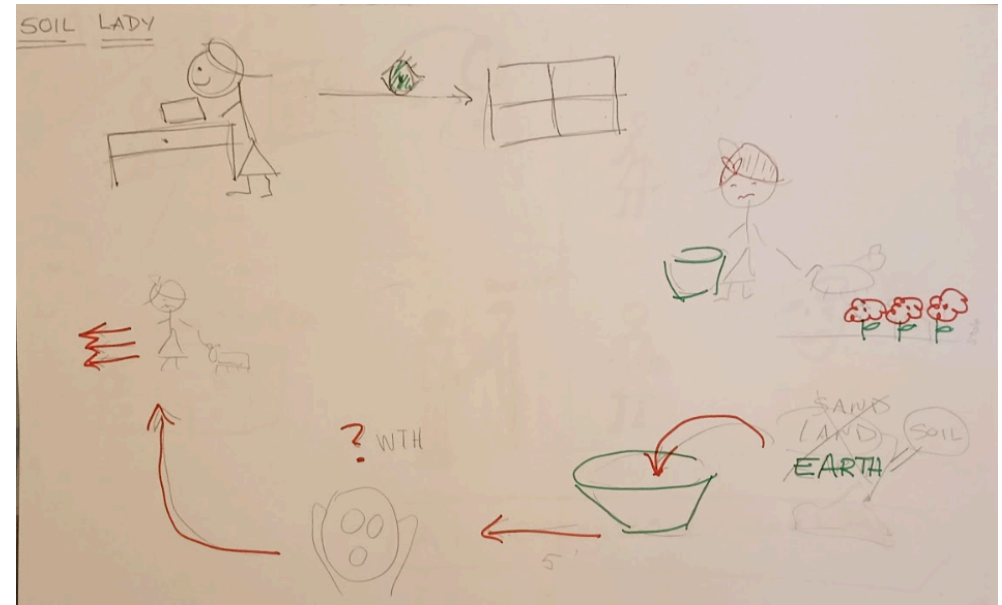
