# LIGHTING INSTRUCTIONS: Read Instruction before lighting

- Insert 1 x AA battery into ignitor (Battery not included)
- Push and turn the control knob to between LOW and HI.
- 3. While pushing the control knob, hold ignitor button until burner is lit. Release the ignitor button. Keep the control knob pushed for 3 more seconds then release the control knob.
- If the burner does not light, wait 3 minutes then repeat steps 2 ~3.
- Adjust flames to desired size with the control knob.
- 6. To turn off, simply push and turn the control knob to the OFF position.



## INSTALLING PROPANE TANK INSTRUCTIONS

1. OPEN THE FIRE PIT DOOR AND BRING OUT THE REGULATOR.



4. INSERT PROPANE TANK AT AN ANGLE SUCH THAT THE BOTTOM OUTER EDGE OF THE PROPANE TANK IS WITHIN THE SLOT

## REMOVING PROPANE TANK INSTRUCTIONS

1. OPEN THE FIRE PIT DOOR.



2. CLOSE OFF THE PROPANE TANK.



PUSH THE BOTTOM OF THE PROPANE TANK INWARDS WHILE LIFTING THE TOP OF THE TANK OUT TOWARDS YOU.



4. PULL OUT THE PROPANE TANK.



5. DETACH THE REGULATOR FROM THE PROPANE TANK.



6. CLOSE THE FIRE PIT DOOR.

#### Maintenence:

- Keep the burner clear of all flammable and heat-sensitive items.
   Never place fire pit under trees, low-hanging plants, or anything flammable.
- 2. Do not operate the fire pit in an enclosed space. Make sure to have a well-ventilated area outside.
- 3. **Never use accelerants** such as gasoline, lighter fluid, or any highly flammable liquids to start a fire. Always use the electrical ignition to start the fire to avoid damage and harm.
- 4. Occasionally have a licensed professional check all lines and fittings to make sure they are tight and clear from any hot surface during use.
- 5. Children are to be kept under supervision at all times during operation. Make sure to **keep everyone at a safe distance** to enjoy the fire.
- 6. Keep water or a fire extinguisher close by in case of an emergency

#### **General Care:**

- 1. Allow the fire pit to cool down completely before storing it away. Use the included PVC cover and burner lid when the fire pit is not in use.
- 2. Store in a cool dry place away from sunlight. For harsh weather like snow or hail, move the fire pit to a location away from the elements.
- 3. Keep the burner clean of debris and dirt to prolong the life of your fire pit.
- 4. Never cover the fire pit if it is wet. Completely dry then store away to avoid water staining.
- 5. If needed, use **mild soapy water and a cloth** to wipe clean any dirt or debris. **Never use an oil-based cleanser** to wipe or clean the fire pit. For tougher stains and watermarks, toothpaste can be used as an inexpensive and common cleaner.
