## ABOUT OUR CLUB / FAQs

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### OUR CLUB MISSION:

Nurture a deeper relationship with Christ by fostering a vibrant community through engagement in Bible classes for children and meaningful parent connections.

### WHAT IS ADVENTURERS?

Adventurer Club provides fun and creative ways for children (PK3 to 4th grade) to develop a Christ-like character to discover their God-given abilities and to know how to use them to benefit self, serve others, and to express their love for Jesus in a natural way. Adventurers are taught to memorize the Adventurer Pledge & Law, centering their focus on Jesus as the

source of everything they need to be the best they can be.

**Pledge:** Because Jesus loves me, I will always do my best.

**Law:** Jesus can help me to... Be obedient, Be pure, Be true, Be kind, Be respectful, Be attentive, Be helpful, Be cheerful, Be thoughtful, Be reverent

**Adventurer Song:** We are Adventurers, at home, at school, at play; We are Adventurers, we're learning every day; To be honest, kind and true; To be like Jesus through and through; We are Adventurers!

## **CLUB COST:**

\$80/child ***What's included in fees?*** Fees pay for patches, scarf & slider, Adventurer pin, class materials/supplies and club insurance. **NOT included: Uniforms, special field trips & events.**

## **CLUB UNIFORMS:**

Adventurers should wear their club t-shirt (also known as Class B Uniform) to club meetings and field trips unless otherwise instructed. Official events like Induction, Investiture, participating in Sabbath Service and community service events require Class A Uniform. ## **CLUB HEALTH & SAFETY:**

A medical form is required for each child and all forms are maintained by the club nurse.

ALL leadership, staff and parents are required to complete and pass a background check to ensure the safety of our children. Parents are required to attend all club outings/field trips if their child is participating.

## **ABOUT SPECIAL EVENTS:**

- **Induction Service:** An Adventurer induction service is a formal ceremony where new members are welcomed into the Adventurer Club, and returning members are reminded of their commitment. It's a time to dedicate members to God and the principles of the Adventurer program. The service typically includes the lighting of candles to represent the spirit of Adventuring and the core values of the program.
- **Investiture Service:** An Adventurer Club investiture service is a ceremony that celebrates the accomplishments of club members at the end of the year. It's a formal occasion where adventurers receive awards, honors, and insignias they've earned throughout the year, recognizing their hard work and dedication.

*homeless. Also, every year, the club leads a program at a Senior Resident Facility where they share songs, a message and other talents with them.*

*2 meetings a month (5 hours)*

### ✓ Safety & Supervision

16. Who supervises the children during meetings and trips?

*Parent volunteers, High School student volunteers, Adventurer Parents & on occasion church staff.*

17. What safety measures are in place for outings?

*Medical Forms, Background check requirement for ALL parents & volunteers.*

18. Are the leaders background-checked and trained?

*All parents and volunteers are required to complete and pass a background check in order to participate in Adventurer club.*

### ✓ Faith & Spiritual Aspect

19. What kind of Bible lessons or spiritual activities are included?

*The Adventurer curriculum takes the goals of the Adventurer program—that children will commit their hearts and lives to Jesus Christ and that they will acquire the habits, skills, and knowledge to live for Jesus today—and turns them into fun and practical activities that Adventurers will enjoy.*

*At each level, the curriculum encourages an age-appropriate, active learning approach. Instead of asking children to learn a great deal of factual information, it introduces them to general concepts. The children learn to apply these concepts to their own lives by participating in a wide variety of experiences.*

*The Adventurer curriculum is divided into six levels: Little Lamb is for pre- kindergarten; Eager Beaver is for kindergarten; Busy Bee is for first graders; Sunbeam is for second graders; Builder is for third graders; and Helping Hand is for fourth graders. Each level builds on the previous levels and is especially designed to interest, challenge, and provide successful experiences for children of that grade level.*

20. Do children need to be baptized to participate? *No*

### ✓ Parent Involvement

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## ADVENTURER CLUB HISTORY

The history of Adventurers started back in 1917 when the Primary Reading Course was introduced. This certificate eventually became part of the class requirements. In 1924 the Sunbeam class was taught in a second-grade classroom and a pin was awarded for completing the requirements. The awarding of the Busy Bee pin first appeared in 1928 as part of the commencement exercises at school, and by 1929 the term “Investiture Service” was used to describe the event where they awarded certificates and pins. The Busy Bee Pledge and Law also first appeared in 1929.

The names used for this age group have varied over time and location and included Preparatory classes,

Pre-Juniors, Pre-Friends, Pre-JMV, Pre-AJY, Pre Pathfinders, Achievement classes, and Adventurers.

By 1933, this group was known as “Preparatory Members”. The two predominant classes taught on the West Coast of the United States were Busy Bee and Helping Hands, while to the East they were known as Sunbeam and Builder. All of these classes used the same Pledge and Law, with only slight differences in the other requirements.

By 1938 the term “Progressive Class Work” was used when referring to all the classes from Busy Bee up to Master Comrade.

In 1940 the General Conference outlined two Missionary Volunteer Progressive Classes that were below the Friend class. They were Sunbeam and Builder. They had simple celluloid pins, and where neckerchiefs were desired, tan was used for the Sunbeams and jade green for the Builders.

Because of so many other names being used for these classes, both in the U.S. and overseas, such as “Upstreamer,” “Junior Light Bearers,” “Sunshine Club,” and “Golden Rule,” the MV committee voted on June 10, 1946 that the Pre-Junior classes be named Busy Bee, Sunbeam, Builder and Helping Hands.

In 1953 there was first seen a pre-Pathfinder Adventurers group, and by 1954 Adventurer camps started up in different conferences for boys and girls age 9 and later on for both 8 and 9-year-olds.

The name Adventurers was used again in 1963 for a pre-Pathfinder group, this time at the Pioneer Memorial Church at Andrews University.

In 1974 in the Washington Conference, for the previous 5 years a group called Beavers for the 6 to 9-year-old kids was going on. They had their own uniforms, consisting of yellow shirts or blouses and brown trousers or skirts.

By 1976 the Youth Leaders’ Handbook mentioned the newly revised pre-JMV Classes, and by 1979 in the NAD, “pupils in grades one to four are designated as Adventurers”.

The General Conference Committee minutes of 1985 mentions the Adventurer Class Requirements. The SDA Church Manual of 1986 again says, “Pupils in grades one to four are designated as Adventurers” and by 1989 the General Conference Committee voted to approve organising the Adventurer Club as part of the Pathfinder program and voted in the official Adventurer Emblem.

In 1990 several Conferences tried out a pilot program of the new Adventurer Club materials from the GC which included their own navy blue and white uniforms, their own award patches (triangle in shape) and their own club structure. The following year Norman Middag introduced the new Adventurer Club program to those who attended the Children’s Ministries Convention held at Cohutta Springs, GA. In 1999 the GC Annual Council recommended that a new section, Adventurer Club, be added to the Church Manual.
