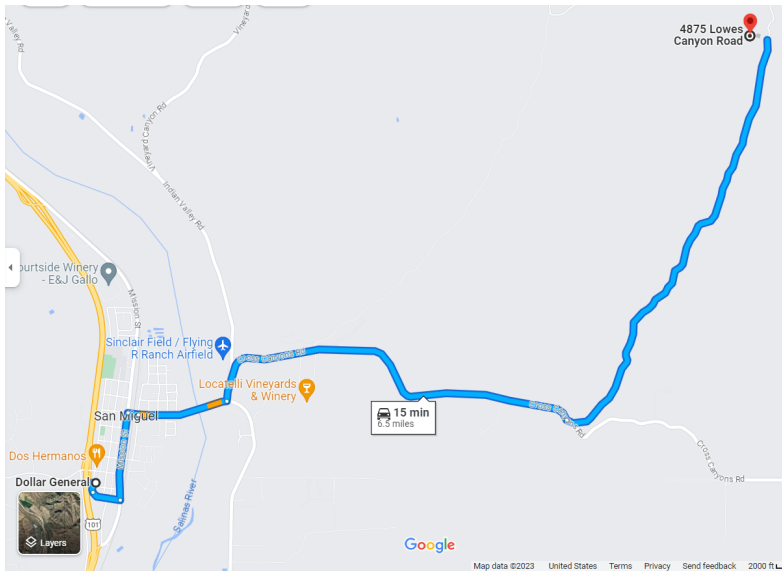

Directions:

If you are coming from HWY 46, follow it to HWY 101 North.
Then follow the directions below.

From HWY 101, take the 10th St. exit in San Miguel. Follow 10th St East towards the Chevron Station, and make a left onto Mission St. Turn Right onto River Rd. Just after crossing the bridge, turn left onto Cross Canyons. Stay on Cross Canyons for about 3 miles and turn left onto Lowes Canyon (a dirt road). Continue on Lowes Canyon for about 3 miles. Once you get to the second cattle guard (about 2 miles), continue for another mile and follow the signs for parking.

HALLOWEEN NIGHTS INFO

General Info:

- Our annual Halloween Nights run every Friday and Saturday evening in October, including Halloween night.
- The gate opens at 6:30PM and closes at 9:30PM.
- Admission to the Hogeland Family Ranch is FREE!
- Haunted Forest tickets are available for purchase at the event and cost \$10 each.
- Concessions are also available for purchase. Concessions include water, hot chocolate, coffee, candy, popcorn, and cookies.
- This is an outdoor event. Please dress according to the weather.

- We will not be open if it is raining.

What to Expect:

- TRAVEL
 - Please note that Lowes Canyon Road is a dirt road.
 - Please drive slow as cows roam free on the properties that border Lowes Canyon Road.
 - You will be on Lowes Canyon Road for about 3 miles before arriving at the Hogeland Family Ranch. It will seem like a really long time, but keep going! You can't miss us!
- UPON ARRIVAL
 - Follow the signs for parking. If you don't see parking signs, you are not at the parking area.
 - Once parked, go through the gate to the right of the parking entrance to enter.
 - Games, movie, and Whirly-Gig are open and available for everyone's enjoyment. Please be respectful of others.
 - Haunted Forest tickets and Concessions can be purchased at the shed.
- HAUNTED FOREST
 - The wagon for the Haunted Forest arrives every 10-15min. Please line up to board in the designated area.
 - Small flashlights will be provided for your use in the Forest.
 - Red lights will be given to the parents of children (or adults) who do not wish to be scared by the scarers. Please do not give these lights to kids. These lights must be returned to the host upon re-entering the wagon.
 - Please stay within the guide ropes while walking through the Forest.
 - Do not touch or move any of the props. We would like to be able to continue this event for many years to come. If the props break because of people touching, pulling, hitting, etc, we will feel less inclined to continue. If you are caught in any way touching the props or jumping the ropes, you will be escorted out of the Forest.
 - Parents are responsible for their children! Please watch your children at all times and remind them to be respectful of and not touch the props. It would be wise to review these rules with them before entering the Forest.
 - Watch your step! The path through the Forest is not paved and the ground can be very uneven in some portions.
 - Be respectful of others. While we do our best to put space between each group going through the Forest, you may come upon another group. Please be patient and respectful of other groups and don't try and push around them. If you feel the need to go around another group, remember to use kind words.
 - Obscene and vulgar language will not be tolerated. Remember this is a family friendly event.
