- One letter of recommendation from either a school faculty/staff member, an employer, or someone who oversees a student's volunteerism efforts. (**THE LETTER SHOULD NOT BE WRITTEN BY A FAMILY MEMBER OR FRIEND**)
- This application must be reviewed and signed by student's school counselor or administrator (see page 2)
