#### For Transfer, Study Abroad and Non Pre-approved courses

- Complete the <u>online petition</u> or the <u>Undergraduate Student Petition</u> Fill out a separate petition for each course that you are petitioning. Attach course syllabus.
- For Paper Petitions: Include the course # (as it appears on TritonLink), course title, # of units, grade
  received, quarter/semester the course was taken, the University in which you were enrolled and specify the
  requirement you want to apply the course toward (e.g. Fulfill Global Health Major Elective Requirement).
  Please also sign and date the petition.
- Submit completed petition(s) & syllabus to the Global Health Advisor (The form can scanned and sent via email to <a href="mailto:ahpadvisina@ucsd.edu">ahpadvisina@ucsd.edu</a> or dropped off in the <a href="mailto:GHP Office">GHP Office</a>).
- You will be notified via the Virtual Advising Center (<a href="http://vac.ucsd.edu">http://vac.ucsd.edu</a>) once your petition has been approved (please allow 2 weeks before contacting advisor).
