Monthly meetings are the second Thursday of every month, February through November, 6:30 – 8:00, at Quarry Hill Nature Center in Rochester. No meetings in November or December. Dues are \$20 for the year & includes all family members.

Meetings are informal, with a wide range of topics throughout the year.

NewBee Fundamentals start at 6:30, with a topic and QA time for the beginning beekeeper. This will walk the NewBee through the year, with suggestions of what to do each month. At 7:00 is a more in-depth presentation for all beekeepers and wannabees. Everyone is invited and encouraged to attend both sessions.

Meetings are free but go the extra step and help support the club by becoming a member. Dues help offset the club costs of room rental fees, speaker fees and donations to the Minnesota Bee Lab.
