A few reminders:

1. **Kids can not leave camp by themselves!** This has been an issue in the past so please remind children that they need a buddy or parent within eyesight AT ALL TIMES.
2. Parents, you are never allowed to be alone with a child that is not yours. You may help with other children, as long as they are with a friend.
3. Kids may only use a knife in a designated zone and only if they have completed their whittling chip.
4. **No child is allowed to add wood to the fire!** Scouts need to complete a badge before they are allowed to do anything with the fire. They can (and are encouraged to) collect firewood though!
