Does the OER follow basic accessibility best practices ?			It would be helpful if the “Manuales” had a descriptive title. In 3 “Un paso adelante” the link is broken. “Paso del norte” video unavailable. Links about Sabine Ulibarrí and Francisco Jiménez are broken.

Overall comments: I think the book is great! I am not sure if I could use it as it is for my first course of heritage speakers but I could certainly use more than a few sections. To better align with Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board Learning Outcomes, it will help to have a section on visual arts and some syntax explanations. It would help to be able to download the text in different formats (PDF, Word). With a Word format it would be easy to use sections of the textbook and adapt them.

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
