Our championship course, built in 2019, offers challenging golf with a mix of grassy fairways, water hazards, wooded corridors and elevation changes. We welcome you and wish you good luck...

1. ***Tee times, tentative tee times are posted on the PDGA event page.**
<https://www.pdga.com/tour/event/50246> Please check your tee times, players drop and things change the day before the event. Players will tee off in groups of 4
2. ***Parking***, please only park in the parking lots not near the buildings or the shelter.
3. ***Arrival and departure***, please do not arrive more than 90 minutes before your tee time, those of you traveling a long distance can fudge that a little bit so you can get stretched before play.
4. ***Check in** ***No check in** this email serves as your check in. After exiting your car, masks are required when safe distancing cannot take place.
5. ***Practice and warm up***The practice basket will be off limits near hole ones tee, you can use any of the other 7 baskets that are part of the campground course, please no more than 4 players at a time near the baskets.
6. ***Water***, there will not be any communal water or snacks provided please pack it in and pack it out when you come, trash cans are limited. Water will be available at tents or shelter on the course along with hand sanitizer. Water will be handed out at your request. Just kidding Greene County will provide lunch, hot dogs, water, and snack both days
7. ***Tees***, please only one person near the tee at a time.

8. ***Do not touch*** other players equipment or gear, do your best to stay six feet apart.
9. ***In case*** there is a backup on a hole, please wait at a different location or near the basket to let others know to wait on their tee. Do not congregate in any teeing area, no more than 4 players near any tee there will be tents in open areas of the course for you to wait in if needed please do not congregate in large groups under the tents.
10. ***Lightning***, it is possible for us to have a couple storms come through, in case of lightning we will suspend play based on PDGA guidelines. If this happens take shelter or return to TD central and shelter in place, in your vehicle.
11. ***Scoring***, we encourage all players to keep score via Udisc or paper card, to validate the official score, you will pick one player on your card to keep score VIA PDGA live scoring, we will set each card up before they tee off, go to <https://www.pdga.com/apps/tournament/score> , use Code **GCPT** for access enter PDGA # to access the scorecard. When your round is finished you will submit the card and I will receive a copy. If you do not have signal WiFi will be available at Tournament central. Make sure to verify each players score by last name or PDGA#
12. ***Finishing your round, ***please check to see if we received your score, make sure all parties agree on the scorecard before submitting. Pick up players pack, after your first round at CFP, hang out and enjoy some disc golf from the grandstands.
13. **AMs** pick up at Hazy ShadeDisc Golf, 638 Watervliet Ave Dayton, OH 45420 Ams should be able to pick up 30 minutes after the last card is in for each division. Official Digital Scorecard Usage Requirements

1. All rules set forth in the Official Rules of Disc Golf Rule 808 Scoring <<https://www.pdga.com/rules/official-rules-disc-golf/808>> are in full effect and must be followed without exception.
2. All players must be informed that digital scoring is both official and authoritative.
3. Paper scorecards must be provided so players can record scores in the event of technical issues.
4. Digital scoring must not be forced upon players.
5. To hand off scoring duties, the player keeping score must sign out on their device and have the next player sign in on their own device.
6. Players in a group may agree on a single player to keep score for the entire round.
7. Discrepancies, provisional scores, or warnings for rules infractions must be recorded for each hole in accordance with rules 808 C and 808 E.
8. Each player must review, confirm and digitally sign-off on their scores at the end of the round by individually entering their name or PDGA number into the app.
