Grading Rubric:

2. Data Science Question and Objectives (10%): The recorded presentation clearly articulates a well-defined data science question and outlines the project's objectives. The data science question is aligned with the chosen subtopic in human-centered data science and demonstrates a thoughtful approach to the topic.
3. Methodology and Data Analysis (20%): The recorded presentation explains the chosen methodology and data analysis techniques used in the project. The rationale behind the selected methods is effectively communicated, and the analysis demonstrates a thorough understanding of the techniques applied.
4. Key Findings and Insights (20%): The recorded presentation effectively communicates the key findings and insights derived from the data science project. The findings are accurately summarized, supported by evidence, and clearly connected to the data science question. The insights demonstrate critical thinking and a deep understanding of the subtopic.
