Subject : Up-gradation of 141 posts of HSG-I IP Line as PS Group B Cadre.

Respected Madam,

It is brought to your kind notice that redesignation of 141 posts of HSG-I IP Line was discussed in the meeting taken by the Secretary (Posts) with our Association on 11/08/2011. It was mentioned in the minutes of the meeting issued vide No. 01/01/2011-SR dated 25th August 2011 that **"The Association was explained that the post of HSG-I was not a promotional post for IPOs and further HSG-I post is non gazetted whereas the post of ASPOs is gazetted. In the background of the above, the proposal could not be considered."**

Service Unions representing General Line officials in HSG-I are demanding that 141 posts of HSG-I IP Line may be transferred to General Line to increase their promotional avenue. Their demand is not justified consequent upon introduction of Postmaster Cadre in Postal Wing as their promotional avenues have already been increased.

This issue was discussed in our 37th All India Conference held at Bangalore on 28th and 29th January 2012 and members have expressed their displeasure on transfer of 141 posts of HSG-I IP Line to General Line as it is promotional posts for IPs and it will affect promotional avenues of IPs.

In view of above, our Association urges upon the Department that 141 posts of HSG-I IP Line may be upgraded as Gazetted in PS Group B as HSG-I Post Offices manned by the ASPOs are more important / bigger offices in comparison to HSG-I Post Offices or posts manned by General Line officials.

A positive action will be highly appreciated.
