Mission: Disciples Seminary was created to provide competency-based theological education for the purpose of training NABNW pastors, missionaries, and church leaders to be sent out from NABNW churches.

Why Disciples Seminary: With the ever-increasing costs of traditional theological education, Disciples Seminary significantly lowers that cost for an accredited degree that brings a theological education under the NABNW local church.

How it works: Students work with their local NABNW church and a mentor/discipleship team of 3 people who help shape the students' outcomes. Every class, project, and assignment works towards the students' chosen degree outcomes.

FAQ SHEET

Cost is \$300 per month. Grants are available through NABNW.

Disciples Seminary is ATS-accredited by Kairos University.

Degree programs offered are BA/MA, MA, BA/MDiv, MDiv, DMin

Each student is required to:

- Sign off on the NAB statement of faith and student code of ethics

- Have a faculty mentor, vocational mentor, and personal mentor.

- Each student must have a pastor or elder from their NABNW church as one of their mentors.
