




Dear Oakdale Families,

If your child is struggling with homework and would benefit from help at home, consider pointing them to Varsity Tutors for help. The Varsity Tutors Platform, supported by the Ohio Department of Education & Workforce Development, OHLSD, and Oakdale, gives your students more opportunities to learn at their own pace. Oftentimes, it is helpful to have someone to talk to about the questions you have or to see things in a new way. With the Varsity Tutors platform, students can reach out to an expert in the subject or skill they are actively learning. In addition, students can request a chat with a tutor 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, meeting the needs of busy schedules.
