1- They are interviewing the president on TV at the moment.

The president **is being interviewed** on TV at the moment.

2- People steal things from supermarkets every day. Someone stole twenty bottles of whisky from this one last week.

Things **are stolen** from supermarkets every day.

Twenty bottles of whisky **were stolen** from this one last week

3- They were repairing the traffic lights yesterday.

The traffic lights **were being repaired** yesterday.

4- They haven't stamped the letter.

The letter **hasn't been stamped**.

5- Did they send the e-mail? Who sent the e-mail?

**Was the e-mail sent? Who was the e-mail sent by?**

6- They didn't catch the thief.

The thief **wasn't caught**.

7- You can't wash this dress, you must dry-clean it.

This dress **can't be washed**, it must be dry-cleaned.

8- We never saw him in the dining-room.

He **was never seen** in the dining-room.

9- Nobody has used the room for ages.

This room **hasn't been used** for ages.

10- Passengers leave all sorts of things in buses. The conductors collect them and send them to the Lost Property Office.

All sorts of things **are left** in buses (by passengers). They **are collected** and sent to the Lost Property Office by conductors.
