UM-Flint Admission & Degree Requirements

- 1. Completion of an Associate in Applied Science (AAS) or similar degree, such as Associate in Applied Arts & Sciences (AAAS). The applicant should have at least sixteen (16) transferable semester hour credits which apply toward the General Education requirements of the UM-Flint. The approval of specific programs & of the transferability of credits toward the BAS degree rests with the BAS Committee.
- 2. Completion of the Applied Science program, consisting of technical credits taken as part of the associate degree program, & one of the following options, chosen in consultation with an advisor, & allowing pursuit of areas of interest in some depth.
 - Option 1. Any one of the minors offered at the UM-Flint, found under the Program Listings section of the Catalog.
 - Option 2. 15 credits in each of 2 disciplines of the student's choice, including at least 9 in upper-level courses (courses # 300 or above) with at least 3 in each discipline. Note: A discipline is defined as any approved current departmental course prefix (BIO, PHL, HCR, etc.). UM-Flint BAS Disciplines .
- 3. Completion of at least 33 credits in upper-division courses (courses numbered 300 & above), including at least 30 taken at the UM-Flint.
- 4. Completion of at least 124 credits. No more than 30 credits in business courses, including both transfer credits & credits earned at the UM-Flint, may be counted, with the exception that a student with an Associate in Applied Science (AAS) or similar degree in a business program may retain all transferable business credits if that total exceeds 30, but no additional credits in business taken at the UM-Flint may be applied to the program. (Students who wish to take more business courses should plan to apply to the School of Management & work toward a Bachelor of Business Administration degree.).
- 5. All UM-Flint graduation requirements, including General Education requirements, at least 30 credits taken at the UM-Flint, including the last 30 credits, & a cumulative grade point average of C (2.0) or better in the concentration & in the total work at the UM-Flint.
