Website Accessibility Statement

Brentor Parish Council wants everybody to be able to access the information on its website as easily as possible. We recognise that some people face extra challenges when using digital devices and have redesigned our site to maximise accessibility. We have:

- Used a theme that is WAG AAA compliant, the highest compliance level.
- Removed images as far as possible and used alt-tags to describe their contents.
- Used clear and understandable English when writing our pages.
- Ensured that pages are responsive, clear, easy to read and uncluttered.
- Included the ability to alter the contrast and size of text.
- Used a sans-serif font for clarity.
- Regularly check the site to ensure compliance.
