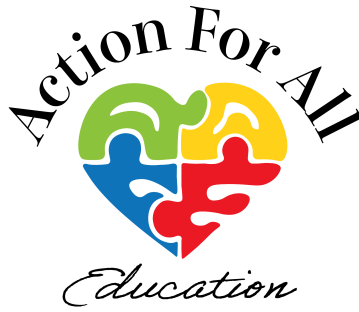




AFAE Camper Guide 2025

Thank you so much for your interest in AFAE Summer Camp 2025! Please read through the following guide to make sure you understand the application process. Our summer camp includes fun activities that aim to center project-based learning.

Application Overview

All campers must fill out one application per person. The application will ask questions regarding camper preferences and needs to better match him/her with a counselor that will support them one-on-one throughout the entire camp. You will complete the application through this link: <https://tinyurl.com/afaecamp25>

The Priority deadline is March 15, 2025. Please fill out the application by this date as we need time to process and pair your camper with our counselors. Applications received after this date cannot be guaranteed a spot in our camp. We process the applications in the order we received them. You will receive a confirmation email after you submit your application. AFAE will schedule a Meet & Greet with the camper and one of the camper's family members.

Who Can Participate?

Campers must be 3 years of age or older.

Campers of all abilities are welcome.

Tuition and Fees

AFAE Summer Camp tuition is \$700, including a \$100 deposit. The tuition covers the costs of camper's participation in our activities. Payments can be made via Zelle, Paypal (credit card and other card payments), cash, and checks.

Meet & Greet

After camper's application is filled out, we kindly ask the camper and one of camper's parents/guardians to come to our AFAE Campus at 1150 N Knollwood Cir, Anaheim CA 92801

for a 30-60 minutes Meet & Greet to get to know the camper and for us to better support/understand the camper's needs. The meeting time will be shared and scheduled on Saturday or Sunday to better accommodate families!

Counselor Selection

All of our counselors HAVE TO apply to support our campers. Prior to welcoming the counselors into our AFAE team, interviews will be conducted with our Leads. Counselors will also attend mandatory training with our Staff, which includes teachers of all grade levels and special education teachers.

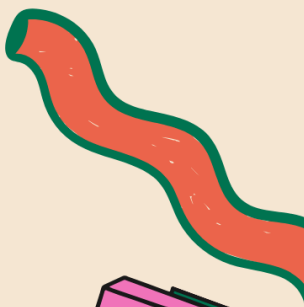
