Application for Admission

Please complete the following requirements before applying to Waconia National Honor Society. **Sophomore and Junior students are eligible to apply.** Once the application is turned in, it becomes the property of the NHS Committee and NHS Advisors. Shortly after the applications are due, the NHS Committee meets. The group discusses the qualifications and standards that indicate a strong NHS candidate. No one outside the NHS Committee is allowed to see the packets or scores, including candidates or parents. The list of those students the NHS Committee recommends for induction is given to the NHS Advisors and WHS Administrative team. They check the list to make sure that each candidate is a “citizen in good standing” at Waconia High School. Students are then notified of their pending status via a personal letter. If a student is not recommended for induction into NHS, the NHS Committee encourages the candidate to continue to develop themselves in the four areas of NHS and to become a candidate again in the future if they are a sophomore. In this situation, the NHS application process will begin anew, with new volunteer experiences and leadership points for a student’s junior year.

Scholarship

To be eligible for Waconia NHS membership students must prove a **3.55 GPA** at the end of the 2nd trimester of the year of application. **Attach a current Waconia High School transcript from Infinite Campus and highlight or circle all AP courses and Cumulative GPA.**

Service

Waconia NHS defines service as the voluntary contributions made by a student to the school or community, done without compensation and with a positive, courteous, and enthusiastic spirit. Students must provide the required documentation of **at least 40 service hours** to be eligible for Waconia NHS membership. The NHS Committee encourages participation in a variety of volunteer activities and emphasizes that service hours goes **above and beyond** normal community or school involvement. **Please note the following regarding service hours:*

- Parent Signatures are NOT accepted for any service hours completed. Individual projects, please provide photographs
- Feed My Starving Children: please include the yellow slip of paper that documents your time or the printed digital confirmation
- America Read will count towards service hours but not Leadership Points
- Mission Trips & Summer Camps: up to 20 hours will be accepted for these service activities
- Avoid using any volunteering from the **Leadership Category** for this Service Category (AKA "double-dipping"). This now includes youth camps organized by a WHS team (i.e. youth volleyball camp) or other activities your WHS team organizes or is volunteering in.

Leadership

Student leaders are persons who display influence and initiative; they are those who are resourceful, dependable, good problem solvers, and promoters of school and/or community activities. Leadership points are accepted for **spring activities documented from the past school year, not the current**. This is due to the fact that applications are due at the beginning of the spring activity season. **For example, if a sophomore is applying and that student played softball as a freshman, then it should be included as an activity below. If that same sophomore did not play a spring sport as a freshman but is currently enrolled in softball as a sophomore - that activity cannot be included below.*

2. Have you ever helped anyone feel accepted in an awkward situation? How? Has anyone ever helped you?
3. How have you changed over the past year? Have you changed for the better?
4. Describe a time when you went far above the call of a situation without expectation of reward or recognition.
5. Have you ever been able to resolve a conflict between two people? How did you do it?
