We, NEON AURELIUS ("we"/"us"/"our") as the data controller take the protection of your personal data very seriously. Therefore, we handle your personal data as confidential information and in compliance with the statutory data protection regulations as well as this Privacy Notice.

This Privacy Notice provides you with information on how we process your personal data when you use our online services ("Services"), specifically our website ("Website") or sign up for any of our newsletters ("Newsletter").

1. What kind of your data we process

You are under no obligations to provide us with the data we ask you for. However, if you do not provide your personal data, you will not be able to use Services we provide. Should the provision of your personal data be mandatory by law, we will inform you separately thereof.

In order to provide you with our Services to its full extent, we will collect the categories of personal data set out below:

Website user

When you use our Website, we may automatically collect your:

- IP-Address
- Date and time of your inquiry
- Time zone difference to Universal Time Coordinated (UTC)
- Content of your inquiry (precise site)
- Access status/HTTP-status code
- Respectively submitted volume of data
- Website of the inquiry
- Browser
- Operating system and its UI
- Language and Version of the browser software.

Newsletter receiver

If you sign up for our newsletter, we collect the following data:

- Personal identification information (Name, email address)
- Time and date of the registration

2. Cookies

Cookies are small text files that may be installed on your computer when you visit a website. Cookies are generally used to provide site visitors with additional functionality within the site. Cookies cannot access, read or modify any other data on your computer.

Our website does not use any kind of Cookies.

3. Purposes of processing your data

We will process your personal data set out above for the purpose of:

- A. provision of our Website including all associated Services;
- B. further improvement and development of our Website;
- C. detecting, preventing, and investigating attacks on our Website; and
- D. transfer of information about our activities and products.

4. Legal bases of the processing

We process the categories of your personal data listed above on the following legal bases under the General Data Protection Regulation ("GDPR"):

- We process the categories of personal data set out under point "Newsletter receiver" exclusively on the basis of your consent according to Article 6(1)(a) GDPR.
- We process the categories of personal data set out under point "Website users" on the basis of our overriding legitimate interest according to Article 6(1)(f) GDPR to achieve the purposes in point 3 A to C.

5. Transfer of your personal data

To achieve the purposes set out above, we will transfer your personal data to the following categories of recipients:

Mailjet

Mailjet is a service provided by SAS Mailjet, 4 rue Jules Lefebvre, 75009 Paris, France (Mailjet) for managing e-mail addresses and sending messages. We use Mailjet for sending surveys, reminders, confirmation emails, and other personalised emails to large groups of people.

Only the names and email addresses required for sending the newsletter are transferred and temporarily stored. Email addresses are used exclusively in the context of the Services and are

not passed on to third parties. This constitutes a justified interest pursuant to Art. 6 (1) f GDPR. If appropriate consent has been obtained, the processing is carried out exclusively on the basis of Art. 6(1)(a) GDPR. This consent can be revoked at any time.

Mailjet may use the recipient's data in pseudonymised form, i.e. without assignment to a user, to optimise or improve its own services, e.g. for technical optimisation of the distribution and presentation of the newsletter or for statistical purposes. However, the distribution service does not use the data of our communication recipients to contact them itself or to pass the data on to third parties.

According to Mailjet, they store your personal data, only as long as it is necessary to provide its services. Mailjet will delete your data when we delete you from our address file.

Vercel

Our website is hosted by Vercel Inc., 340 S Lemon Ave #4133, Walnut, CA 91789 ("Vercel"). The personal data collected and provided by you when you visit our website (see above) is processed by Vercel as a hosting provider. YouTube

With your consent in accordance with Art. 6 Para. 1 sentence 1 lit. a) GDPR the YouTube embedding function for displaying and playing YouTube videos. The service provider is Google

Ireland Limited, Gordon House, Barrow Street, Dublin 4, Ireland, parent company: Google LLC, 1600 Amphitheater Parkway, Mountain View, CA 94043, USA.

We use the extended data protection mode, which, according to the provider, does not start storing user information until the video is played. The moment the embedded video starts playing, your IP address is transmitted to YouTube. A cookie is also set to collect information about your user behaviour. According to information from YouTube, these are used, among other things, to record video statistics, improve user-friendliness and prevent abusive practices.

We will delete or anonymize your personal data as soon as it is no longer needed for the purposes set out above in any case we will delete or anonymize your personal data latest after one-hundred-eighty days following the relevant matter having been addressed and/or following inactivity, whatever occurs earlier.

Thereafter, we will retain your personal data (i) as long as required under statutory retention obligations or (ii) as long as potential legal claims, where personal data is needed to raise or defend against the claim, are not yet time-barred.

7. Your rights in connection with your personal data

Under applicable law, you have the right to (under the conditions set out in applicable law):

- obtain confirmation as to whether and what kind of personal data we store about you and to request copies of such data;
- request rectification or erasure of your personal data;

- request us to restrict the processing of your personal data;
- object to the processing of your personal data;
- withdraw any consent previously granted for the processing of your personal data (withdrawing your consent does not affect the lawfulness of processing based on your consent before your withdrawal);
- request data portability; and
- lodge a complaint with the competent supervisory authority.
