Mathematics Requirements

Calculator Usage

• In KS3/4 mathematics, we teach both non-calculator and calculator-supported mathematics skills to all students. The calculator we recommend is the CASIO fx-991ES Plus. It is easily found on Amazon.sa, in Jarir and many other stationary stores. This is a solid and reliable calculator containing all the functionality required to support your child from Year 7 through A-level mathematics. A graphical display calculator (TI84, CASIO Prizm) is not allowed for any assessments at BSD; therefore, we do not recommend purchasing one. The free online graphing websites are often a better option for students.

Other supplies

- Students should be prepared for class every day with their exercise book, textbook, pencil, pen, ruler, and calculator.
- Additionally, students will require a geometry kit containing a protractor and a compass.
 Your child's teacher will inform your child ahead of time about lessons where these will be required.
- KS3 students will be issued a textbook for the duration of the year.
- The school subscribes to a mathematics learning platform and details will be shared with your child.

Year 9 fast track and KS4/KS5 mathematicians will be required to purchase their own textbook from the textbook list provided.
