



Senior Parking and Driving on Campus

All senior students who have been randomly selected for parking have been permitted to park in the paver parking lot and will need to pick up a placard for the assigned lot.

Placards must be hung from the rearview mirror of the vehicle.

A second parking pass can be issued and used if you plan on driving another vehicle or are sharing a spot with another senior student (this information must be on file with Mrs. Melanie Walsh, mwalsh@lfschools.net (in the Deans' Office).

If you forget your placard or have another vehicle, you must immediately report this to a member of the security team or email this information to mwalsh@lfschools.net. Mrs. Melanie Walsh will then provide you with a temporary parking pass.

If someone parks in your spot please DO NOT park in another senior parking spot. Take a photo of the car parked in your space and email it to Mrs. Walsh - mwalsh@lfschools.net and park in the diagonals of the exit drive.

Please follow the guidelines below. If you are found in violation of any of these guidelines, you may lose your parking privileges and will not be refunded the registration cost:

- Abide by the on-campus speed limit of **10 mph**.
- Obey all stop signs and directions by security and traffic personnel.
- Do not park in any parking space that is not your own, including but not limited to the front of the school or in any unmarked parking space on campus.

All interested students will need to reapply for a spot in the second semester. Applications will be available in late October.

PLEASE NOTE: School authorities may inspect and search school property and equipment owned or controlled by the school, this includes vehicles in the parking lot.
