Hot Topic: <u>Biden Administration announces six-part plan to</u> <u>further combat COVID-19</u>

## What are we hearing?

 The Biden Administration is reinforcing and expanding its plans to get people vaccinated and combat COVID-19.

## What should you know?

The Biden Administration has announced a new six-part plan to combat COVID-19.

#### 1. This is what's changing:

- Teachers and school administrators
  - Teachers and staff at Head Start and Early Head Start programs, the Department of Defense (DOD), and the Bureau of Indian Education-operated schools will be required to get vaccinated
- Federal employees and contractors
  - All federal workers and contractors will be required to be vaccinated, removing the option to opt for a weekly test instead
- Medicare and Medicaid health care providers
  - Workers in most health care settings that receive Medicare or Medicaid reimbursement will be required to be vaccinated

#### 2. This is what may change in the near future:

- Private employers
  - All employers with 100 or more employees may soon be required to ensure their workforce is fully vaccinated or require unvaccinated folks to get a weekly Covid-19 test
  - Employers with more than 100 employees may soon be required to offer paid time off to employees to get vaccinated
