January 4 - March 14	Shakespearean English, romantic tropes, forbidden love, suicide	<b>Romeo and Juliet</b> by William Shakespeare
March 21 – May 16	Mental health, bullying, depression, teen suicide	Thirteen Reasons Why by Jay Asher

The units will consist of many different types of lessons and assignments. While we will be reading some in class, you will be expected to read each week independently **at home**. This is so class time can be spent on activities and lessons.
